## Submitting Resolutions

Resolutions you want considered by the B.C. Regional Council must be received at the New Westminster office no less than 15 days prior (15 working days, excluding weekends) to the opening of council. In addition, please note that in accordance with the council bylaws, Article 9: Amendments, that:

***The bylaws of the Regional Council may be amended by a 2/3 majority vote to approve a resolution from a local union or a recommendation of the Executive Committee provided that all local unions have been given 30 days notice of a resolution or recommendation to amend the bylaws***

Therefore, any resolutions pertaining to **bylaw changes must be submitted no later than October 16, 2019**. The 30 days notice would then be given to locals no later than October 22.

**The 2019 resolutions deadline is October 21, 2019**. If possible, we encourage you to send in your resolutions prior to this date to help assist with printing and shipping deadlines.

### What are Ways to Make Resolutions Clear for Everyone to Understand?

- Cover only one main issue per resolution.
- Use sentences that are clear, direct and short.
- Use words that your readers will easily understand - avoid jargon and acronyms.
- Be specific. Explain what you want to see happen: what you want to change, how you want it done, who you want to do it, and when you want it to happen.

## Driving to Whistler

**IMPORTANT INFO:** The Sea to Sky highway is a mountain highway, where conditions can be unpredictable due to rapid changes in elevation and weather. A trip that starts in sunshine may also encounter slush, ice, heavy snowfall or compact snow. For safety in winter conditions, passenger vehicles are required to have winter tires installed to drive on the Sea to Sky between October 1 and March 31.

- Snow Tires (3 peaked mountain and snowflake symbol)
- M & S Tires (tires rated for Mud and Snow, usually all season)

If you choose to drive to Whistler, please ensure your vehicle complies. The RCMP conduct regular checks on this highway as of October 1.

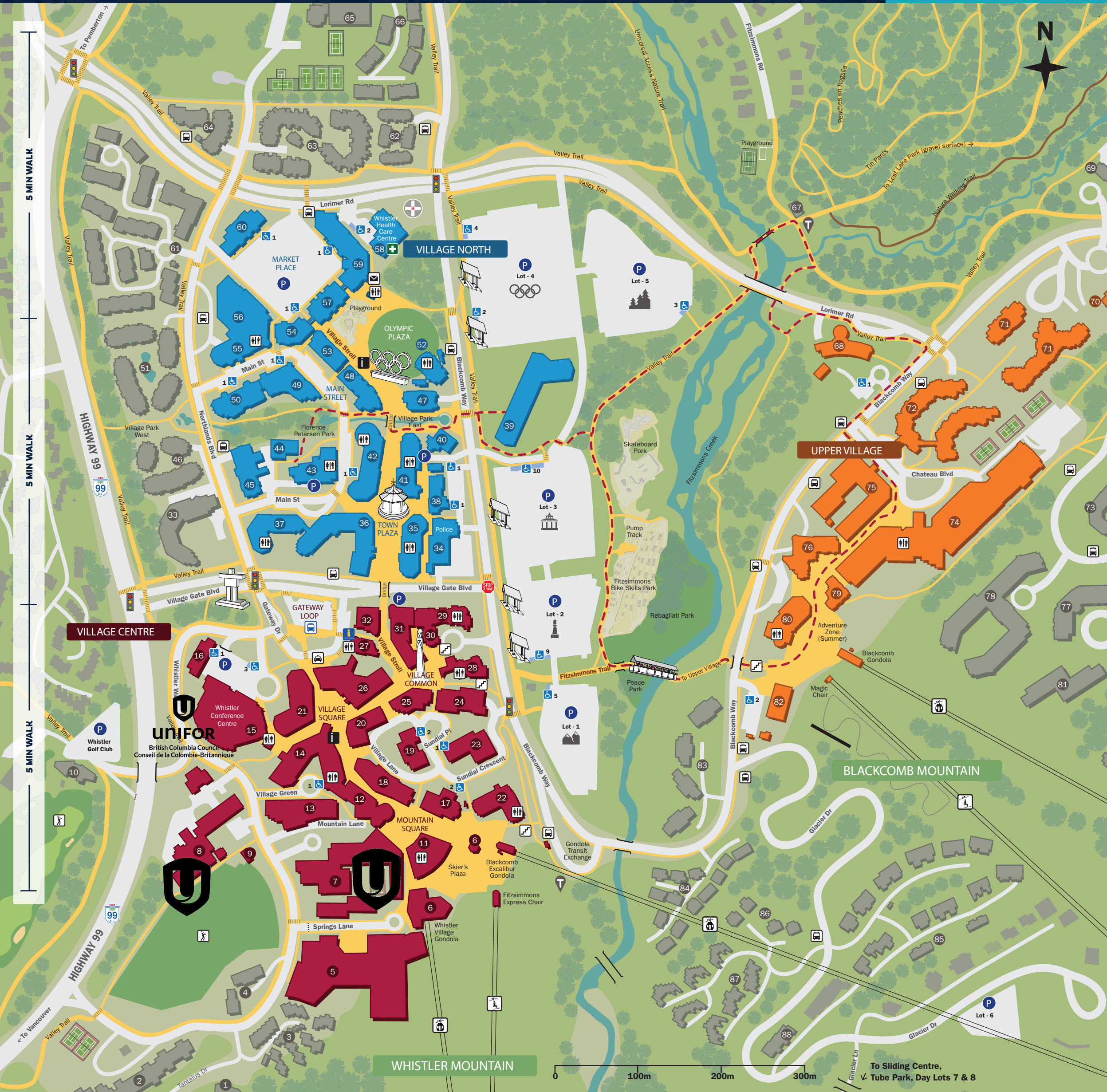

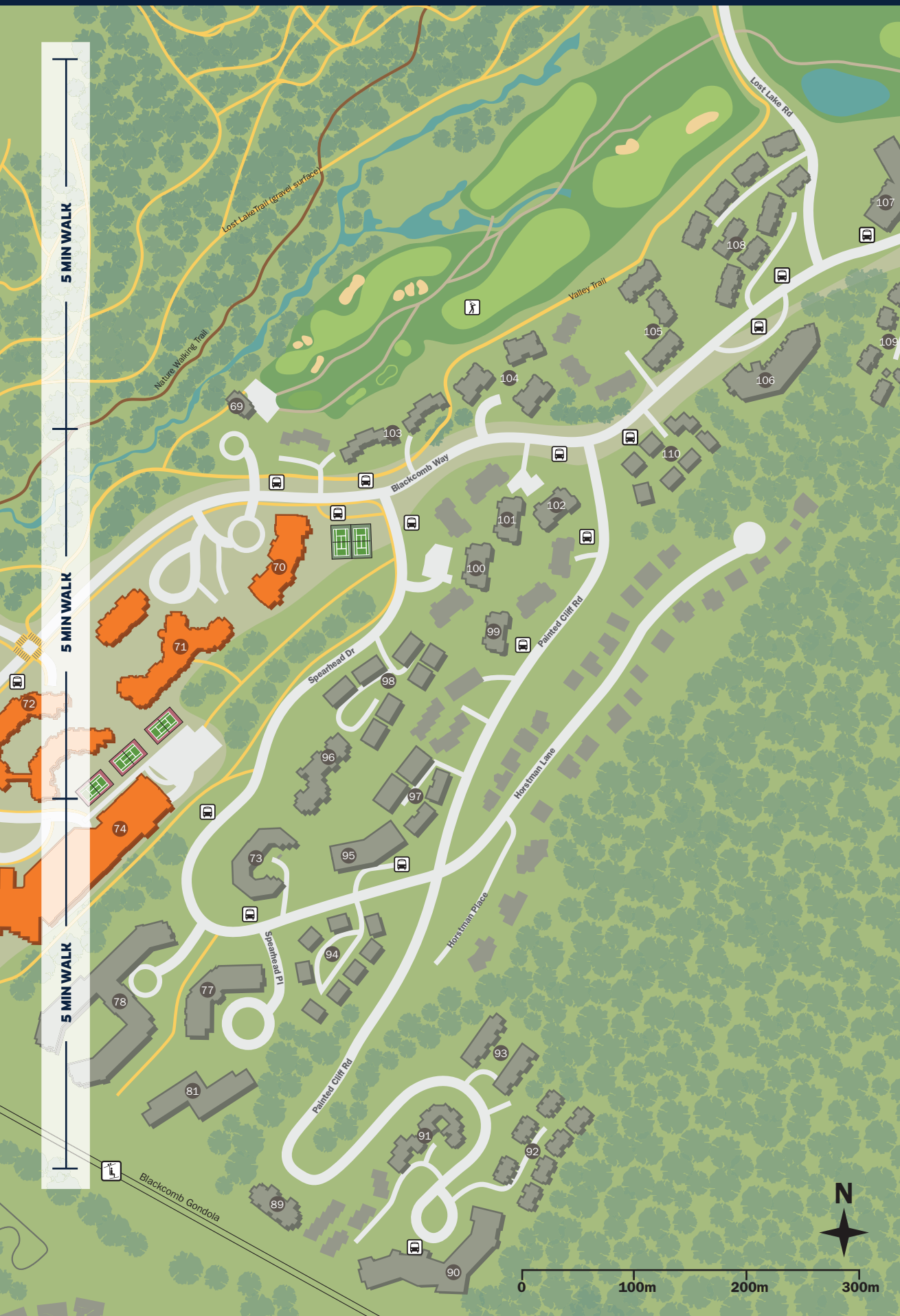

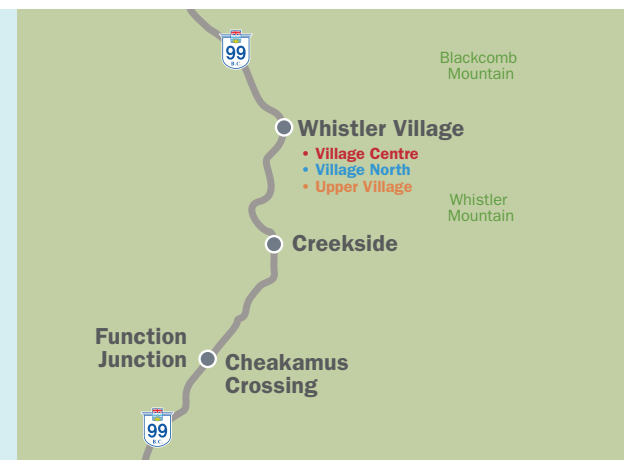

# Winter Tires in BC



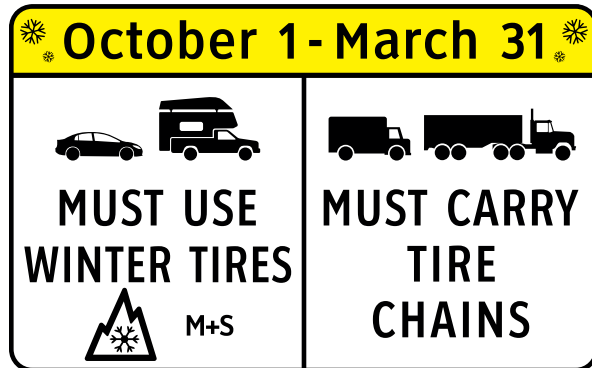
Winter tires are required in BC on many rural highways and high mountain passes in the Interior, North and Vancouver Island.

BC is one of only three provinces in Canada that define a winter tire and specify where their use is required.

## Definition of a Winter Tire

BC's *Motor Vehicle Act* creates the authority to designate roads where winter tires are required.

- *Motor Vehicle Act* Section 208 gives the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure authority to post signs that specify where winter tires are required, and the vehicle types on which they are required.



- The signs define that both severe winter condition (mountain snowflake) and all-season mud and snow (M+S) tires are acceptable winter tires for cars and light trucks and that large trucks must carry chains.

To be considered a winter tire, a mountain snowflake or an M+S tire must also have at least 3.5 mm of tread depth across the whole tire.

## Selecting the right tire

Both the mountain snowflake and M+S tires meet the minimum requirement for winter tires in BC. The Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure and the RCMP recommend that regular travellers on BC's highways equip their cars and light trucks with the mountain snowflake tire, which is the best tire available for winter conditions.

M+S tires are a viable option for motorists who live in areas without frequent winter weather and who plan their trips to coincide with periods of better weather. All drivers should be prepared to drive with added care and caution when winter conditions are encountered.



## Motorcycles

Motorcycles are not required to be equipped with winter tires in BC. The Ministry does, however, recommend motorcyclists not travel provincial highways when winter conditions are present or forecast.
